Semi-structured questionnaire for local stakeholders

Overview

1. Can you briefly describe how the pilot agency in your area has been involved in *Making Tracks*. What has been offered to young people? How does this differ (or not) from what is usually offered?
2. How many young people have you referred in to the pilot service?

Impact of the project

3. In your opinion, what has been the impact of *Making Tracks* on staff practice – e.g. has it fostered more joint working?
4. What has been the impact on young people?
5. Has *Making Tracks* had any impact on local organisational knowledge across services?
6. Do you have any comments to make regarding the 'distance travelled' over the last project year in terms of whether *Making Tracks* has led (or could lead) to sustainable ways of joint/more joined up working? (Note development support offered from Youth Access – is this a necessary feature of making the project work?)

9. Are there any changes in the last year that you wish to highlight? (Refer back to interim report and views given then)
10. Are there any importance local contextual issues that might have impacted (or may impact in near future) on *Making Tracks* (e.g. local reorganisations, service cuts, waiting lists)?
