BACKGROUND

Youth Access delivered a conference in May 2022 to coincide with the Government's consultation period for the proposed 10-year Mental Health Plan.

The conference aimed to bring together our community of members and young people to further demonstrate the importance and need for the Our Minds Our Future programme, and the crucial role YIACS (Youth Information, Advice and Counselling Services) play in meeting that need by supporting young people in their local communities.

Taking place virtually via Zoom over three weeks, sessions were co-designed and co-delivered by Youth Access staff, young people, external facilitators, and sector colleagues.
